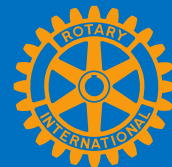

Rotary Opens Opportunities

WIIFM for Rotary Clubs

- Build strong continuing relationships with Alumni
- Trigger Alumni involvement in Club activities and projects
- Guest speaking role
- Alumni to form basis of new clubs e.g. Rotex, Rotaract
- If your club provides what Alumni desire then
- Alumni reinforces age and gender diversity and a corporate networking structure

Rotary Opens Opportunities

What is needed from your club?

- Appoint your Club Alumni Co-ordinator
- We will email a request to you
- We will provide your club with your known Alumni
- Your Alumni Co-ordinator to contact each of your Alumni
- Meet with your Alumni
- How about an “informal” Alumni honorary membership
